

Urologist – Barrie, Ontario

Barrie is a city one hour north of Toronto, situated on Lake Simcoe. The city has been called the “gateway to cottage country”. The city is ideal for family-oriented individuals and outdoor enthusiasts. Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre (RVRHC) is the region’s referral centre. There is a busy urological service of six urologists, providing a wide spectrum of urological care. The catchment area is large, and the area’s population is growing quickly.

We are seeking a urologist to share hospital resources (0.5 FTE) with one of our experienced urologists. Outpatient care would also be carried out in Dr. Foell’s office, with the recruit having mostly his/her own patients. Remuneration would be fee-for-service plus an on-call stipend. This position will be offered as a one-year locum, with the potential to extend to a permanent position.

We are seeking a team player with excellent interpersonal skills to work in this collegial environment. Excellent general urology surgical skills are required, and various areas of subspecialty interest could be accommodated.

Applicants must have successfully completed specialty qualifications from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and be independently licensed or eligible for licensure in Ontario. Applicants must be eligible to work in Canada without restrictions.

The start date would be somewhat flexible to the timeline of the successful candidate, but would ideally be in July 2021.
