In addition to our complement of General Practitioners, our medical staff includes specialists in Internal Medicine, General Surgery, Gastroenterology, Neurology, Ophthalmology, Radiology, and Urology.

South Muskoka Memorial Hospital is located in Bracebridge, just two hours north of Toronto in beautiful "cottage country" surrounded by vibrant natural beauty, pristine lakes, majestic forests and rocky shorelines.

We are currently recruiting a Locum Urologist (0.5 FTE) with an opportunity of progression to a full-time Associate credentialed staff position (1.0 FTE). The successful applicant will work with two other local Urologists in providing comprehensive urologic care to the community, with a referral base within Central Ontario including Muskoka, Parry Sound and Haliburton. On-call commitment includes extended regional coverage in cooperation with colleagues at Orillia Soldier's Memorial Hospital.

Remuneration is based on fee-for-service OHIP billings plus HOCC (Hospital On Call Coverage) stipend.

The successful candidate will be invited to participate in undergraduate and graduate teaching activities and candidates that progress to a full-time Associate position will be eligible to apply for an academic appointment with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine.

Applicants must hold an MD or equivalent with completed training in Urology and must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. The successful candidate must have obtained the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Fellowship in Urology. Proficiency in laparoscopic surgery and familiarity with management of genitourinary cancers would be preferred. Although not required, a fellowship in these areas would be an asset. Applicants will be required to demonstrate experience working with teams and possess strong interpersonal and collaborative skills.
