

Mark Assmus

Dr. Assmus is a clinical lecturer in the Department of Surgery at the University of Calgary and Southern Alberta Institute of Urology, where he established the first prostate enucleation program in the province. He was previously an instructor of urology at Northwestern University. His research interests include benign prostate disease, surgical technologies, kidney stone disease and quality assessment/improvement.

Dr. Assmus completed his medical degree and urologic surgical residency at the University of Alberta and went on to complete a master's degree in public health, focusing on health policy and management, at the Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health in Indianapolis. Concurrently, he completed an Endourological Society fellowship at Northwestern University, focusing on complex kidney stone management, benign prostate disease, and prostate enucleation surgery.
