Dr. Fleshner is a clinician-scientist and uro-oncologist within the Division of Urology at the University Health Network in Toronto. He is the Director of UHN Biospecimen Services, including the Princess Margaret Cancer Biobank, and is the Founder and Director of the McCain GU BioBank (MGB). He holds the Princess Margaret Hospital Foundation Love Chair in Prostate Cancer Prevention. He is a professor of surgery and past-Chairman of Urology at the University of Toronto.

Dr. Fleshner's research spans translational, clinical, and health services research, with an interest in the discovery of biomarkers to diagnose prostate cancer and differentiate indolent from aggressive disease. He has published over 600 peer-reviewed papers and received over \$50 million dollars in peer-reviewed funding. Dr. Fleshner works with community groups to increase diversity of the MGB and facilitate outreach initiatives for underrepresented and high-risk communities.
