Dr. Samplaski is an associate professor of urology and the Director of Male Infertility, Andrology and Microsurgery at the University of Southern California. Her research interests include ethics and infertility, optimizing access to male fertility care, and coordination of male and female fertility care.

Dr. Samplaski has spent time in Ghana with the International Volunteers in Urology medical outreach program. She is committed to the advancement of the field of male reproductive medicine through her research, and she has over 100 peer-reviewed publications and book chapters. She has received numerous awards and accolades for her academic accomplishments, including the prestigious Bruce Hubbard Stewart Award for Humanistic Medicine.

She completed her residency training in urology at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation. She then completed a two-year fellowship training program in male infertility and andrology at the University of Toronto.
