Bernard H. Bochner, MD

Dr. Bochner is an attending surgeon on the Urology Service at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center and a professor in the Department of Urology at the Weill Medical College of Cornell University. He served as Vice-Chairman of the Department of Surgery and is the immediate past co-Director of the Pelvic and Reconstructive Surgery Group at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. Currently, Dr. Bochner is the inaugural holder of the Sir Murray Brennan Endowed Chair in Surgery at MSKCC.

Dr. Bochner's clinical focus in in urologic oncology, with a particular interest in urothelial cancer and pelvic reconstructive surgery. He is actively involved in translational research and is the co-PI of a project as part of the MSKCC Bladder Cancer SPORE grant. He heads up the Bladder Cancer Disease Management Group at MSKCC. Nationally, Dr. Bochner has participated as a member of the TCGA project in bladder cancer, led the urothelial cancer working group of the Genitourinary Task Force of the American Joint Committee on Cancer (AJCC) for the last two staging revisions, and is a member of the American Urological Association/SUO/ASCO/ASTRO Muscle-Invasive Bladder Cancer guideline panel. He is a fellow in the American Surgical Association and current Secretary/Treasurer of the Society of Pelvic Surgeons.
