

J. Curtis Nickel, MD, FRCSC

Dr. Nickel is Professor Emeritus in the Department of Urology at Queen's University and an associate staff urologist at Kingston Health Sciences Centre.

His research covers inflammatory, benign prostate, and pain diseases of the urinary tract. He has over 625 publications, has been on the editorial board of twelve urology journals, immediate past-editor of the AUA Update Series, has presented in over 45 countries, and has been funded by US NIH and Canadian CIHR for most of his career. He served as President of the Canadian Urological Association in 2017.

Dr. Nickel has been honored with several awards throughout his career, including being named CIHR Tier I Canada Research Chair (2007–2022) and the first ever SIU Mostafa Elhilali Award for contributions to international urology research (2018), as well as the American Urological Association's Distinguished Contribution Award (2009), Lattimer Medal (2020), Honorary Lifetime Member (2021), and the Hugh Hampton Young Award (2023).
